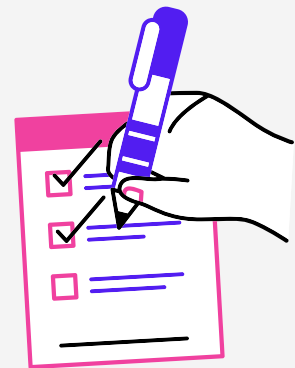

The General Assembly provides a discussion and decision forum for intrastate business and acts as a Committee-of-the-Whole to decide issues of general interest, conducts elections, and provides oversight for all Assembly functions.

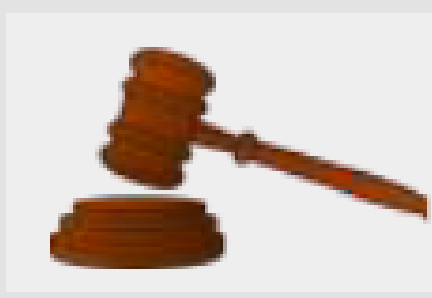


Business/International Assembly

The International Business Assembly, which is composed entirely of State Citizens, conducts the international and interstate business of the Assembly.

Jural Assembly

The Jural Assembly provides the Court Services and oversees the Grand Jury, Trial Juries, Officers, and functions of the courts.



Assembly Militia

The Assembly Militia is focused on promoting public safety within the boundaries of their State and is the "well-regulated" militia guaranteed to each State for its internal security..

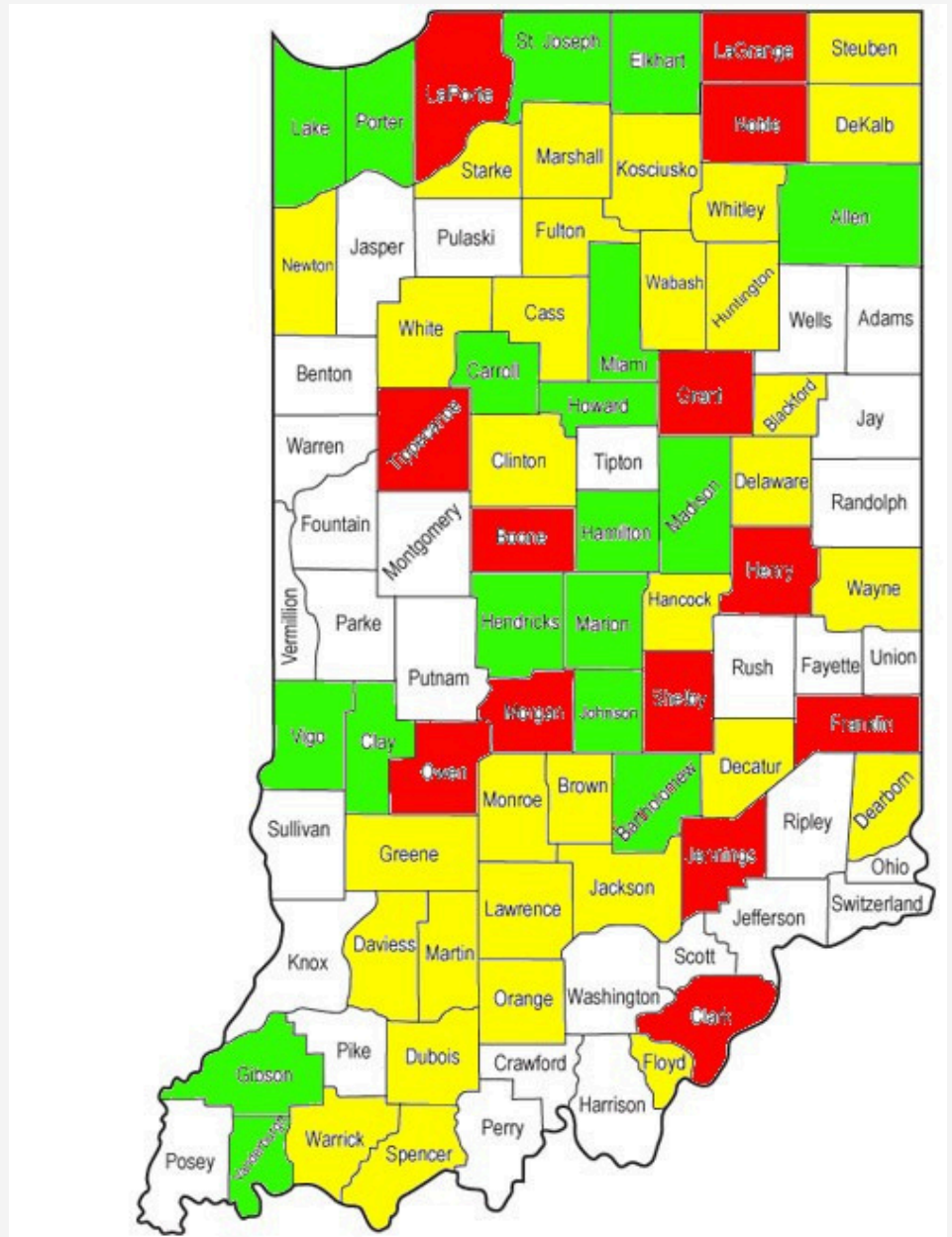

Mission Statement and Disclaimer

The Indiana Assembly© Mission Statement

Our Indiana Assembly is dedicated to the restoration of a complete and fully operational land and soil jurisdiction State and County court system serving the people of Indiana, the preservation of the National Trust, the enforcement of the Public Law, the upholding of the Federal Constitution owed to our State and People, the re-population of our land and soil jurisdiction, the filling of vacated Public Offices, and the reclamation of our material and intellectual public and private assets. To these ends we, the living people of Indiana, have called the eligible Indiana Nationals and Citizen electors to assemble and to serve as Jurors and Officers, and we have established the process and procedure to qualify Jurors and others competent to hold State Citizenship and Public Office. We do this peacefully and without rancor in the exercise of our unincorporated powers and capacities.

Disclaimer:

We are engaged in the practice of self-government.

Everyone here is volunteering their precious time and skill. Each one is an American with rights and prerogatives equal to your own.

They are doing this work out of mutual necessity, to restore the lawful American Government.

Demands for service, temper tantrums, and misplaced anger are inappropriate.

This country does not belong to its government. This country belongs to the people who live here. And you are one (1) of them.

The Right to Peaceably Assemble

"... The Summoning Authority bears the responsibility for the action, and must do their level best to make sure that each State Assembly is composed of properly declared and qualified individuals, that each State Assembly is properly structured and functioning with a General Assembly, International Business Assembly, Public Courts, and Militia, and that everyone is made aware of their rights, duties, and responsibilities--- whereupon the State Assembly is deemed to be fully seated. This we are endeavoring to accomplish, and as it hasn't happened in 160 years, we have started from scratch..."

The Civil Peacetime Flag

The American people are not at war.

Our States and our Federation of States were never involved in the mercenary conflict known as the Civil War. It was fought completely by the Territorial and Municipal corporations within the air and water jurisdictions. The Land and Soil Jurisdiction has been at peace continuously and remains so to this day. That's why we fly the Civil Peacetime Flag instead of our wartime flag, Old Glory.

Assembly Participation and Behavior Guidelines

From Article 3022 - "Focus for Assemblies"

Don't let new people come into your Assembly and commandeer it with their "ideas" about how things should be and how things should be run. **Nationality is a birthright. Assembly membership is a choice.** If they want to join, fine. Put them to work, but also set boundaries.



While we cannot deprive people of their birthright, we can and must throw disruptive people out of meetings and refuse to let them interfere with getting the work done. Participation in Assemblies is predicated on being polite and productive members of the community--- troublemakers and anarchists and the me-me-me people need to be disciplined, educated, and if need be, shown the door.

The Assemblies are business organizations engaged in very serious and important business. We have to "set the tone" for new members and establish the group values, so that the group as a whole disciplines people to be polite, logical, business-like, and mature. The moment anyone starts acting like a Seventh Grader and gossiping and being paranoid, it's up to the whole group to let that person know that that behavior pattern is not appropriate, not productive, not appreciated, and won't be tolerated. Shun gossip and fear-mongering and it will disappear.

- The United States of North America

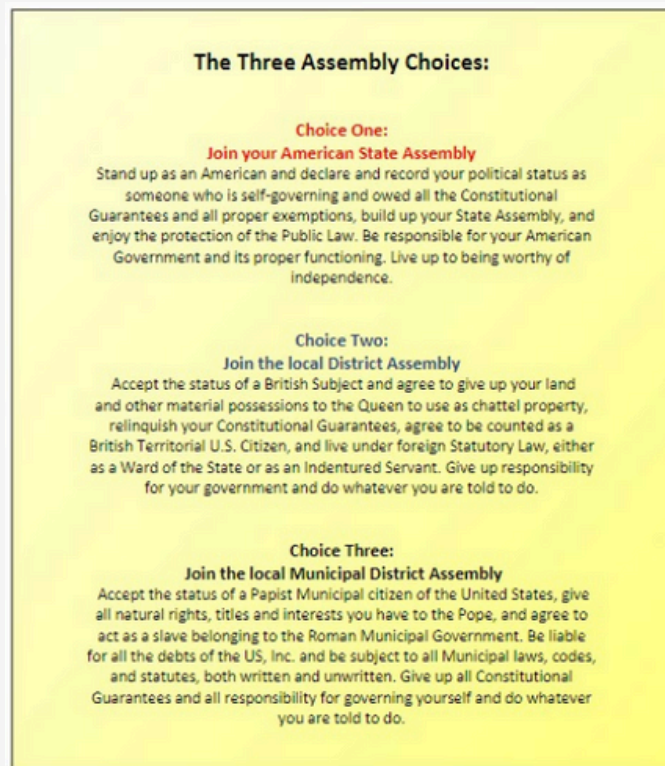
There is Only One Rightful, Lawful Assembly

Sure, anyone can assemble. But there can be only one actual, factual, rightful and lawful Assembly that is the foundational part of our American government. And you found us! This is the Assembly that has been summoned by the only legitimate Summoning Authority, The United States of America, our unincorporated Federation of States. Any other organization calling itself an Assembly is not recognized by the Federation and has no lawful standing as a part of the true American Government.

Though it hasn't quite hit home yet for many people, incorporated organizations like LIFE FORCE, the Reign of the Heavens Society, the Kingdom of Hawaii, the Republic, the United States of North America, the Unity States of America (Russell Godin's operation) and similar efforts all represent foreign governments.

You've Got Three Choices!

At the outset, after an individual has been advised of the facts and has made their declaration recovering their birthright status as an American, they have a choice. They can join their State Assembly or not.

Once they have made that decision and have joined the State Assembly, they have also accepted certain obligations as members and participants in the State Government.

If they are eligible to serve as State Citizens they are automatically considered members of the International Business Assembly as well as the General Assembly, and must show reasonable good cause for not serving in this capacity.

The same is true of the General Membership and the Jural Assembly. All members can be called upon to serve as Jurors and form two common law jury pools depending on the nature of each case to be considered --- whether the matter is totally within state borders, or is international in nature. Again, as State Assembly members we are obligated to serve unless we show good cause otherwise.

The same is true of the Militia. We are expected to participate unless there is good cause why our participation is not possible or ill-advised at a given time.

This element of duty which is not present in Common Committees means that each of these Four Pillars is in fact a separate Assembly in its own right.

Everyone who is eligible is expected to serve as State Citizens, if they can, as Jurors, if they can, and as Militia members, if they can.

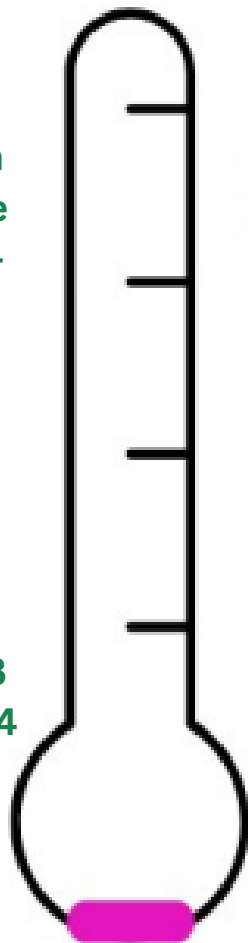

American State National

Eligibility:

- 21 years of age
- Born on American soil, Naturalized, Green Card holder, or 7 years living here if undocumented.

Paperwork:

- 1779 One Page Declaration
- Birth Certificate
- 2 Witness Testimonies

Obligations:

- Obey the Public (non-statutory) Law
- Keep the peace

Limitations:

- Do not hold public office
- Cannot vote on international matters
- Can attend and express their views at public meetings only

From Article 3014 – “Orientation for Newbies”

“**State Nationals** ... are free of any obligation to the State Government except that they are obligated to keep the peace. This means that State Nationals enjoy the protection of the State and the enforcement of their Constitutional guarantees by the State, and so long as they don't harm anyone else or ruin or steal property belonging to others, they are free to live their lives and enjoy the peace.

“For an adult to choose the status of State National usually implies some condition of need. People who are too old or too sick to fully participate, people who have overwhelming burdens at home, people who suffer from mental issues and addictions, people who are working for other governments, and all minors, are owed the status of State Nationals--- and our protection.”

American State Citizen

State Nationals who choose to serve the State Government in some capacity, such as Jurors, Militia Members, elected officials, or hired officials.

Eligibility

- 21 years of age
- Born on American soil, Naturalized, Green card holder, or 7 years living here if undocumented
- Live on Home State at least 1/one year and a day
- Member of the Assembly in good standing
- No dual citizenship or divided allegiance to any other political entity or government (*Tribal governments, Foreign Nationals, or State-of- State or other foreign government allegiances through BAR registration, Real Estate License, Federal Insurance Agent License, Medical License, Commercial Driver's License, etc.*)

Paperwork:

- 1779 One Page Declaration
- Birth Certificate
- 2 Witness Testimonies
- Common Carry Declaration
- Declaration of Political Status with mailing
- Revocation of Voter Registration and election to pay taxes

Obligations:

- Serve as members of their Assemblies
- Honorably fulfill their public office duties
- Enforce the Constitutions

From Article 2492 – “Assembly Administration Questions and Covid 19”

A **State Citizen** holds a unique allegiance to their State of the Union, so as to guarantee as much as possible, no conflicts of interest on their part.

Unique means "singular". While participating as a State Citizen and acting as a member of a State Assembly you may not hold any other allegiance to any other government. Period. This prohibition applies to Tribal Governments, State of State governments, the U.S. Federal Citizenships, and more obviously foreign governments, like England, Germany, and France.

or
ASC?

You can be either: (1) a State National or (2) a State Citizen.

Being a State National or a State Citizen does not necessarily mean that you qualify to be a State Elector. You can be part of the State Jural Assembly and serve as a Juror without being a State Elector. You can be elected to a Public Office, such as Sheriff, without being able to vote for yourself. This is because of the pesky issue of letting non-landowners vote on questions that only affect landowners, and therefore the requirement that State Electors be landowners.

State Nationals, State Citizens and Electors

From Article 1566 – “For All The State Jural Assemblies - 25 State Electors, State Nationals, and State Citizens,” By Anna Von Reitz

State Nationals = everyone born within the physical geographical borders of a State. A National has no particular duty to serve the State other than to obey the Public Law (Non-Statutory Law) and keep the peace.

State Citizens = those State Nationals who additionally choose to serve the State Government in some capacity, such as Jurors, Militia Members, elected officials, or hired officers.

State Electors = those State Nationals who own land in the State and meet other requirements such as legal age, etc., to participate in State Elections.

Connecting, Document, and Recording Services

Assembly Email News Letter: Ensure that you are getting the Assembly's emails: Assembly calls, training, Prosperity Card information, and the like. Self-governing means You have to add yourself to the list and follow through with Confirmation at <https://zc.vg/sf/FAZQu>

- Notes: You may have to confirm Not Spam on your side a few times. Get in the habit of checking the SPAM/Junk/Promotions/etc. folders daily to ensure none slipped in. Also, Delete all SPAM/Junk/Promotions/etc. after each check so you don't mix up what you have already confirmed.

- Scan all documents into a PDF. Do not take a picture and then convert to PDF. This still creates it as a photo first and uses additional ink to print. Photos of any documents, including the BC, will be Rejected. **Note:** There is an exception to the Cancellation of VOTER Registration, see below for more details.
- Documents that are Not Federation Approved Templates, or Altered/Modified beyond the personal details, or include any Territorial (such as 'USMOI') or MUNICIPAL verbiage will be Rejected as they are not included in the Federation Approved Templates.
- Documents presented with any form of Parse Syntax, including :John-Mark: Doe. or the use of 'i,' in place of 'I,' will be Rejected. See list of common Anna Articles later in this News Letter.
- Documents presented with an 'additional Notary page,' or ST OF ST Notary signed to an Assembly Recording Secretary or Assembly Public Notary block will be Rejected, as they are not acting in that capacity. Be ware! Some Notaries will do it anyway knowing that it Invalidates the document in their Jurisdiction as well.
- A complete presentment of each of the Notices includes:
 - VOTER Registration-copy of Cancel Voter Registration sent to all places Registered and Voted, to include either copy of Postage Paid Receipt(s) or stamped copy from walking in to a COUNTY office to Cancel. **Notes:** A photo converted to PDF of an envelope with postage stamps doesn't meet the requirement. Should be sending Priority Mail, Registered Mail, or Certified, which would provide a Postage Paid Receipt. Even if using Postage Stamps to pay, you have to hand to the Postal Worker, then get a Receipt. If using Postage Stamps without additional service(s), still hand to the Postal Worker and ask for Tracking. This is a Free Service, and will give a Receipt that confirms delivery is in transit.
