

International Business Standing Committee

(composed of State Citizens and is responsible for conducting international business for the Assembly, including setting up the State of State organization needed to complete Reconstruction of the confederation and Federal Republic)

- 1. International Education and Security Committee (reads and assesses international and global news and trends, keeps up with security issues and concerns, is briefed on international issues impacting the States of the Union, may make presentations and recommendations to the General Assembly)
- 2. Congressional Committee (vets candidates for Congressional offices in The Continental Congress and once the Reconstruction is complete, will also vet candidates for the United States Congressional Delegation, will receive

nominations, publish election notices, conduct elections for these offices, provide ballots, and secure and announce the election results)

Militia Special Purpose Committees

- 1. **Membership Committee** (evaluates candidates and vets them for specific jobs within the Assembly Militia, seeks to encourage participation in the Militia, understanding of the Militia's role and support of the Militia's functions)
- 2. **Provisions Committee** (acts as the Quartermaster for the Militia, evaluates needs and means to meet those needs for equipment and other provisions needed to carry out Militia duties)
 - Need ASCs and ASNs to compile of list of what equipment and other support measures they have available should it be needed in an emergency.

 - Who knows Morse Code and willing to teach others?
 - Who has workable Heavy Equipment that could be employed in an emergency?

- 3. **Education Committee** (develops tests and educational materials and programs to train Militia members)
 - Seeking ASNs and ASCs with teaching and/or former military experience to step up and support in this area.
 - Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training is <u>highly</u> encouraged for everyone, regardless of military experience. Operations Committee (develops short and long-term operational goals for the State Assembly Militia, creates plans to implement projects and goals, evaluates Militia readiness, acts as oversight for the Militia, works with the Ombudsman's Office to resolve complaints related to the Militia and Militia Service, works with the Peacekeeping Task Force)
 - Establish online and offline communications.
 - Evaluate risks and hazards across the State to determine what is in place and what needs to be supported.

 - Proper signs posted Remember that you have to give a contact name and number or email or mailing address when you put up "Private Property" or "No Trespass" signs, they are not effective if you don't give a name and contact.
 - Fire extinguisher and know how to use it
 - Flying the peacetime flag
 - Family plans for safely exiting house in case of fire or other necessity.
 - A "reconnect" plan -- how they will locate each other if they have to leave their home, if telephone services are shut down, etc.
 - Safety and First Aid Kit
 - two emergency "blankets" that reflect body heat for each member of the family and one for pets, adequate gauze, medical tape, saline solution, padding to dress multiple wounds large and small multiple times, bandaids, a range of antibiotic and antifungal sprays and creams, elastic bandages for sprains, anti-diarrheal medicine, laxatives, water purification tablets and Life-straw water filters for everyone, safety matches, candles, needles, microfilament, pain killers, scissors, sharp knife, tweezers, cold symptom medicine for fevers, antihistamine medicine, rubbing alcohol, and pure grain alcohol like Everclear, a hot water bottle/cold compress, basic vitamins, especially Vitamin C.
